Violin— Our preferred partner Musical Innovations both rents and sells violins, and they are happy to assist PCS students. Be sure to mention that you are a PCS student when you stop by. Musical Innovations is conveniently located at 150-G Tanner Road. They can be reached at 286-8742.

Bow—consult your child’s teacher as to size, brand and quality level

Wipe Cloth—necessary for cleaning the violin, can be made of soft or micro fiber material

Shoulder Rest or Sponge—would be wise to seek advice from the teacher as to the preference or size

Folding Music Stand—folding ones are best for greater ease of transportation

Light or Sensitive Violin Rosin—Though this may come with the violin, if you are renting the instrument the rosin may not be in good condition. Please consult your teacher.

Method books—your teacher will purchase these for you and PCS will bill your account

Metronome—helps your child internalize the beat and develop strong rhythmic skills

Tuner—excellent aid for your child to ensure correct pitch

Music bag— helps make transporting books from home to lessons easier and can also help keep books organized at home (when they’re not being for practicing, of course!)

Assignment book—this is provided by PCS, but make sure to bring it to every lesson!
